<u>Accomplishments</u>

- Established Babysitting Training Courses
 - In 2006, it was identified that there was a void in this community for an affordable, high quality babysitter education program. Starting with the ABCs of Babysitting and currently with the AAP B.L.A.S.T. program I initiated and maintain courses to meet that need. This course educates approximately 120 pre-teen and teens annually in safe babysitting techniques, emergency prevention, safety, CPR and First Aid.
- Established Workplace Responder Program

In 2007, based on a workplace death, Noridian and BCBS of ND approached us for a customized training program. I initially created the curriculum for a Workplace Responder program. I then taught the initial courses as well as provided quarterly on-site emergency drills and bi-annual refresher courses. The program was taught in corporate locations including: Fargo, ND; Jamestown, ND; Grand Forks, ND Denver, CO; Salt Lake City, UT; and Des Moines, IA.

- AED Grant

In 2010, in response to a request from the Fargo Cass Public Health and Dakota Medical Foundation I negotiated the sale of 30 AEDs. These AEDs were placed in 15 non-profit organizations and 15 first responder entities within a 75 mile radius of Fargo.
